IMPORTANT: Please note that numbers are prepared a year in advance, because of the pandemic changes may happen. At the IASAP-BV and ISoA, we will do our best to inform you rapidly if there are any changes that may affect the total cost of participation in the program.

A. YEARLONG PARTICIPATION, costs and fees

Because the world situation is unpredictable and changing rapidly, program fees cannot be considered definite this year. The International Programs Committee anticipates the Program Fees to participate in the IASAP-BV in 2021/2022 for the yearlong program (two semesters) to be \$15,750.

Participants applying for a full academic year make a commitment to the yearlong program, September through May. If for any reason a student participating in the program must leave the program prior to its conclusion in May, they are still required to pay the full program fee of \$15,750 and no refunds are available.

Program fee is in addition to regular tuition and fees required for enrollment at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The program fee includes housing at the double occupancy rate, round-trip airfare Chicago to Barcelona and other expenses incurred on behalf of the students for some of the required academic activities of the program.

Because the University locks in tuition costs based on the student's entry year, the tuition fee for 2021-2022 is known. Fee information is voted on by the Board of Trustees yearly, so that figure is estimated based on fees for the current year.

B. ONE-SEMESTER PARTICIPANTS, cost and fees, seniors

Because the world situation is unpredictable and changing rapidly, program fees cannot be considered definite this year. The International Programs Committee anticipates the Program Fees to participate in the IASAP-BV in 2021/2022 for the one-semester program (Fall or Spring) to be \$10,500.

Participants applying for a full academic semester make a commitment to the one-semester program (Fall or Spring). If for any reason students participating in the program must leave the program prior to the end of the semester conclusion, they are still required to pay the full program fee of \$10,500, no refunds are available.

Because the University of Illinois has guaranteed tuition rates for undergraduate students, we can accurately anticipate tuition for program participants. University fees are voted on yearly by the Board of Trustees. Until that takes place, the fee part of the figure is estimated based on fees for the current year.

IMPORTANT NOTES: The Program Fee includes monies for airfare and the housing reservation; both are non-refundable after the School incurs these expenses. Any necessary account adjustments (usually for students not going on the group flight) will be reflected in the August charge.

If a student withdraws from the program prior to July 1st, any uncommitted portion of payments they have made (except those fees marked "non-refundable") will be considered for a refund. If a student withdraws from the program after July 1, the total amount paid from Payment 1 (\$3,500) will not be reimbursed.

Charges and payments are made through your Student Account. The \$500 deposit required in March is considered a good faith deposit demonstrating your commitment to the program. Without prior approved arrangements, failure to make any or all payments will be cause for removal from the program and replacement by an alternate. Keep all receipts and other records of payment. Anybody who is moved from the Alternate List to the Participants List must pay the \$500 deposit within two weeks from the date of written notification.

NOTES

- ¹ Students participate in the IASAP-BV as UIUC students and thus pay UIUC tuition based on their year of entry. There is a reduction in fees because participants are off campus. The fees charged are the general fee and the health insurance fee. Above figures are based on UIUC entry their freshman year. These figures may be different for students who joined the School at other times or as transfer students from other institutions.
- ² Includes round-trip group airfare Chicago-Barcelona, housing at Student Residence (double-occupancy), fees necessary to complete student-visa in Spain, all instruction related costs (registration in courses, etc...) and most field trips (including travel and lodging during the two multi-day field trips of the year, one in each semester). It does not include: personal expenses (i.e., meals); school supplies and materials; and costs of independent travel.

<u>Special notes on students' housing costs:</u> The Program Fee includes housing for students at double occupancy (two students per unit). The housing deposit and utilities (water and electricity, including heat) are not included in the housing fee, and are the responsibility of the student.

- ³ International Insurance: this is mandatory health-care insurance for all students from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign who participate in a program of study overseas.
- ⁴ Application Fee: non-reimbursable fee charged by the Study Abroad office at the time of applying to participate in the program.
- ⁵ Personal expenses are not collected by the University; they are the student's personal living expenses and must be added to the above totals. Personal expenses are estimated from students' feedback; they generally consist of daily living and school-related expenses (meals, utilities, supplies, textbooks, model-making materials, printing and photocopying, etc...) and traveling expenses. They depend on individual spending habits and the fluctuation of the exchange rate. Estimated average personal expenses during non-travel periods (approximately 31 weeks): \$200 per week (\$6,000/year; this includes food, personal hygiene, housing utilities, school supplies.)

Estimated average personal expenses during travel periods (approximately 6 weeks): \$550/week (\$3,300/year; this should include normal daily expenses plus lodging during travel periods). Estimated transportation costs during travel periods (airfare, train, buses, etc...): \$1,500/year (this will obviously depend on the mode of transportation, destinations, etc...).

IMPORTANT: Except for Personal expenses (which are not collected by the University), all payments are made through the Student Account. An initial payment is required in April after accepting admission into the program. Partial payments are due in May, August and January.
